COURSE DESCRIPTION

Training material: Industrial Training Corporation video-based programs. This training course consists of six (6) different topics. The Measuring Instruments Module is a comprehensive program covering the most commonly used measuring instruments such as a steel rule, vernier caliper, outside micrometer, telescoping gauges and dial indicator. Other modules include Bolting and Fastening (fastener performance, proper preloading, fastener designs, installation, bolting patterns, lubrication, locking devices, frozen fasteners, head markings), Mechanical Blueprint Reading (visible/hidden lines, sectional views, break lines, dimensions, isometrics, orthogonal views), Hand Tools (vises/clamps, screwdrivers, hammers, punches, wrenches, pliers, saws, chisels, taps & dies, reamers, files), Blueprint Reading and Use (piping system prints, fluid power system prints, machine prints, how to read prints), and Lifting and Rigging (hand-operated hoists, overhead traveling cranes, mobile cranes, ladders/scaffolding).
