**COURSE DESCRIPTION**

This training program is for those already employed as collection systems workers as well as those new to the field. It is an introduction to the operation and maintenance of wastewater collection systems. Several objectives include: (a) describe why the work of a collection system worker is important; (b) describe the three types of wastewater collection systems; (c) identify main types of sewers; (d) describe basic components of the collection system; (e) describe what is meant by and what should be done about inflow, infiltration, and exfiltration; (f) indicate the importance of dissolved oxygen and microorganisms in wastewater; (g) describe the difference between aerobic and anaerobic decomposition; etc.
