COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course is designed to teach students to identify the basic components of pumps and pump processes and to describe the purpose of pumps in the wastewater field. The course is divided into three parts. Part I covers: (a) basic components of the pump assembly; (b) basic types of motors, starters and enclosures; (c) motor controls; and (d) troubleshooting. Part II covers: (a) centrifugal pumps; (b) basic components of centrifugal pumps; and (c) control of centrifugal pumps. Part III covers: (a) positive displacement pumps; and (b) basic components of positive displacement pumps.
