COURSE DESCRIPTION

108 - NPDES AND UIC PERMITS AND CWA REGULATIONS: This training course is designed to instruct operators, supervisors, and managers on NPDES/UIC permit requirements and other wastewater operations regulatory requirements. The course will include a discussion of NPDES and UIC permits, what they include and how to read them. Copies of all NPDES and UIC permits in the State of Hawaii will be available for students to look at the permit from his/her plant during these discussions. The Federal Clean Water Act (CWA) will be discussed and a summary of the important information from it will be provided to each students. Applicable State of Hawaii Revised Statues and Administrative Rules pertaining to wastewater operations will also be discussed and summaries of the important information from these documents will also be provided to each student. If there are any County directives, ordinances, rules or regulations pertaining to wastewater operations, they will also be identified and discussed. 112 - STATE REGULATIONS: This course is designed for WWTP operators and supervisors. Course covers: (1) O&M inspections, (2) spill protocols (for spills reaching surface waters - spills within the confines of a wastewater facility; spills outside of the confines of a wastewater facility, etc.; (3) enforcement policies and types of enforcement; (4) sewage sludge regulations - what is Part 503, land application of sewage sludge, pathogen reduction, etc.; (5) effluent reuse classes of reclaim water, allowable uses of reclaim water, design requirements for treatment & distribution systems, engineering and other reports needed for reuse projects, etc. (6) underground injection control (UIC) -regulation, definition of a well, examples of injection well facilities, specifics of regulation and how it affects you, and the future developments; and (7) wastewater operator certification - general rule making, role of the Board of Certification, who must be certified, major responsibilities of operators in "direct responsible charge", enforcement, examination, and proposed changes to rules.
